✓ IELTS: The Road to Dreams Begins Here




Established in 1989, the IELTS (International English Language Testing System) is a standardized test of English language proficiency for non-native English language speakers. One of the most widely recognized proficiency test, IELTS respects international diversity and is fair to everyone who sits for the test. It is the world's most popular English testing system and is managed jointly by the British Council, IDP, IELTS Australia and Cambridge Assessment English.

✓ IELTS Modules

The modules are divided into two parts:

1. Academic Module: For those wishing to enrol in universities for higher education
2. General Training Module: For those wishing to undertake non-academic training for immigration purposes

✓ IELTS Scoring

- ✓ Band score of each of the four modules as well as overall score is recorded on Test Report Form
- ✓ Allows institutions to identify candidates strengths and weaknesses clearly
- ✓ Each Band corresponds to a descriptive statement giving a summary of the English of a candidate classified at that level
- ✓ Overall band scores can be reported either in full or half
- ✓ The result is available 13 days after the day of the test



✓ PTE: Test of the Best

A computer based English language test, the PTE Academic exam assesses the four key language skills of listening, reading, speaking and writing. This test helps the institutes and colleges to receive a real measure of the test takers command on the English language. PTE is endorsed by the Graduate Management Academic Council and its scores are accepted by numerous colleges around the world including prestigious institutes like Harvard, Yale etc.

✓ PTE Scoring and Results

- ✓ The overall scoring is based on performance across all tasks
- ✓ Test takers take 80 to 91 items
- ✓ There are 20 different question types
- ✓ The score range is between 10 to 90 points
- ✓ This scoring range is maintained across all sections
- ✓ The results are available online- within 4-5 working days
- ✓ Test takers have to log in to view their results
- ✓ Institutions and colleges have to be sent the scores individually
- ✓ An individual can choose who they want to send their results to







TOEFL

✓ TOEFL: The Major Test




One of the two major English language tests in the world, Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), is a standardized test to measure the English language ability of non-native speakers. TOEFL is a trademark of the Educational Testing Service (ETS), which designs and administers the test. ETS also issues official score reports, sent independently to institutions for two years following the test. A TOEFL score is valid for two years.

✓ TOEFL Test Sections

TOEFL consists of four major sections reading, writing, listening and speaking.

- ✓ In addition to the scores, the official score record also includes a performance feedback
- ✓ This feedback is a reflection of the test takers performance level
- ✓ It also describes the kind of tasks the test takers within a certain scoring range can undertake
- ✓ Educational institutes set their own range of scores
- ✓ There is no limit to the number of times an individual can appear for TOEFL
- ✓ The results are posted online, within two weeks of the test date
- ✓ Scores are also e-mailed to the universities that an individual wants to get into





GMAT

✓ GMAT: Standardized across 114 nations

A Computer Adaptive Test, the GMAT (General Management Admission Test) is intended to assess certain analytical, verbal, writing and reading skills in order to determine a candidate's proficiency to enter a course like MBA. According to GMAC (General Management Admission Council), the test owning council, the GMAT assesses analytical writing and problem solving abilities, along with critical and logical reasoning.

Established in 1953, GMAT is accepted by more than 7000 programs at approximately 2300 graduate business schools across the world. Business schools use this test as a criterion for various programs like MBA, Master of Accountancy, and Master of Finance etc.

✓ GMAT Scoring

- ✓ The total GMAT score range is 200 to 800
- ✓ Two-thirds of the test scores are between 400 to 600
- ✓ Verbal and Quantitative scores range from 0 to 60
- ✓ Verbal scores below 9 and above 44 are rare
- ✓ Quantitative scores below 7 and above 50 are rare
- ✓ Analytical Writing Assessment scores are average ratings of two sections
 1. Analysis of an Issue
 2. Analysis of an Argument
- ✓ These average scores can range from 0 to 6 with half-point intervals
- ✓ Writing scores are computed separately and have no effect on total scores
- ✓ Integrated Reasoning scores range from 1 to 8 in single-digit intervals

✓ The Score Report and Availability

GMAT score reports include all the scores from the last five years, the most recent AWA (Analytical Writing Assessment) responses and background information like:

- ✓ Country of citizenship
- ✓ Gender
- ✓ Date of Birth
- ✓ Contact details
- ✓ Under-graduation institute, GPA, major and date of graduation
- ✓ Integrated graduated study
- ✓ Highest level of education attained

Official GMAT scores that include the AWA scores are available to the test taker and his / her designated score-report schools approximately three weeks after the test.

✓ GRE: The Test of Today!




Introduced and revised on August 1, 2011 the GRE is one of the latest tests to make its mark on the overseas education test field. One of the most widely accepted graduate admission tests in USA and Canada, GRE is designed in such a way that it gives the test takers a friendly and flexible experience. This test is owned and administered by the Educational Testing Service (ETS).

Originally established in 1936, the GRE underwent major changes in its format in 2011 where the test shifted from a question by question format to a more flexible section based format. There was also a change in the scoring format where the overall range was brought down to a 130 to 170 scale from the previous 200 to 800 scale.

✓ Test Content and Structure

The GRE comprises of three broad sections on which the scoring is based:



- ✓ **Verbal Reasoning:** It assesses the reading comprehensions, critical reasoning and vocabulary usage of the test taker
- ✓ **Quantitative Reasoning:** Measures the problem solving ability of the test taker while focusing on basic concepts of algorithms, geometry, algebra and so on
- ✓ **Analytical Writing:** This section tests the critical thinking ability of the test taker. It tests the ability to articulate and support complex ideas clearly. This section comprises of two tasks:
 1. Issue Task
 2. Argument Task

1. An uncounted unscored section may be included anytime after the analytical section. It isn't included in the overall score.
2. An identified research section that is not scored may appear at the end of the test.

✓ Test Registrations and Retakes

- ✓ The computer adaptive test can be taken across the year
- ✓ The test can be taken once every 60 days
- ✓ It cannot be taken more than 5 times every rolling 12 month period
- ✓ All the scores will be recorded as long as they are valid (less than 5 years)
- ✓ It is a varying policy, but universities might look at the best score

SAT

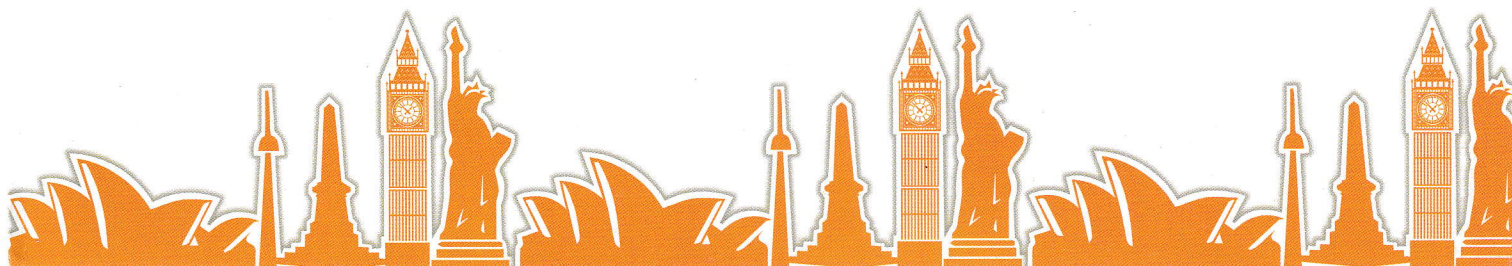
✓ SAT: The Test of the Undergraduates






Introduced in 1926, the SAT is a standardized test widely used for college admissions in the United States of America and Canada. SAT is specially designed for undergraduate courses. If a student is looking to pursue his/her education in a particular field of study, SAT provides the opportunity to take specific tests related to that particular subject. The SAT is owned, developed and published by the College Board, an organization in the United States of America. The current SAT, revised and introduced in 2016, takes three hours to finish plus 50 minutes of an essay.

✓ SAT Pattern

The SAT is divided into two sections:

- ✓ Math
- ✓ Reading and Writing
- ✓ It also consists of an optional section of essay
- ✓ Students are not scored in the essay section

✓ Scoring in SAT

- ✓ The scoring is divided into two sections: 1. Reading and Writing 2. Mathematics
- ✓ Both sections are scored 800 each
- ✓ This makes it a total of 1600
- ✓ 1000 is considered as on average SAT score
- ✓ A score above 1200 is considered very good

✓ Dates and Results

- ✓ SAT is conducted between October to June
- ✓ The dates aren't flexible so the preparation has to be well planned
- ✓ The exam dates are informed by them
- ✓ The results are released within 4 to 5 weeks after the test
- ✓ Results can be viewed online
- ✓ Students can choose to send their scores to the colleges

Together with French, German is the second most commonly spoken foreign language in the EU after English, making it the second biggest language in the EU in terms of overall speakers.

The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages, abbreviated as CEFR, is a guideline used to describe achievements of learners of foreign languages across Europe. It was put together by the Council of Europe with the main aim to provide a method of assessing and teaching which applies to all languages in Europe.

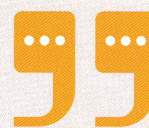
The CEFR in a few words : **Learning, Teaching, Assessment!**

Beginner	A1	You learn how to make simple enquiries in speaking and writing, and to give instructions. You build on your basic grammar skills and increase your vocabulary.
Elementary	A2	You learn how to express yourself adequately in familiar, everyday situations and to read and understand simple texts.
Intermediate	B1	You consolidate and revise basic grammar structures, and learn to lead discussions on interesting topics.
Upper Intermediate	B2	You have a command of the essentials of German. You practise reading, writing and discussing difficult topics and work-related issues.
Advanced	C1	You learn to express yourself clearly both in speaking and writing on a large number of topics and to understand almost all texts.
